ACCIDENT PROCEDURE

Accidents occur despite supervision. Minor accidents are treated at school. Slight cuts and grazes are normally treated by cleaning with water and applying a plaster. Parents are asked to check the cut that evening.

Ice packs are applied in the case of a bruise.

Parents/Guardians are contacted immediately if there is any cause for concern.

If an accident requires attention parents will be notified.

In the case of bangs to the head parents will be contacted if the teacher is concerned

In the event of treatment being required two members of staff will be present.

If an accident requires attention parents will be notified.

In a case of bangs to the head parents will be contacted if the teacher is concerned.

If deemed necessary teachers fill in an Accident Report form. (Folder in Staff Room).

From 11.00 – 11.10 and from 1.00 – 1.30 p.m. children who have an accident are brought by an SNA to the staff room for treatment as described above. No member of staff should find themselves in a one-to-one situation when dealing with an injured child. In the event of treatment being required two members of staff will be present.

If a child is injured badly enough to merit being brought inside the teacher on yard must be informed.

The child's class teacher should also be informed of the incident so they can relay this information to the child's parents/ guardians at home time.

In the event of an accident requiring the immediate attendance of emergency services the Principal or Deputy/Acting Principal has been authorised by the board to do so. The parents/guardians will be informed immediately.
